Code of Conduct for the Students

- Students are expected to maintain highly disciplined behavior in the college campus.

- The 80% attendance is mandatory for the students to appear for the exam.

- The use of mobile is strictly prohibited in the campus.

- Students should keep their vehicles in parking slot only.
- Students are expected to behave mannerly in the campus without disturbing academic and administrative atmosphere.
- Students should keep the campus clean and tidy.
- Students should not damage the college property.
- Students should not invite any guest in the campus without a prior permission of the Principal.
- Groupism among the students is not allowed in the campus.
- The attendance on Independence Day and Republic Day is mandatory for all students.
- In case of a violation of rules, a strict and serious action will be taken against a student.

Code of Conduct for the Teaching Staff

- Teachers should be punctual and attentive towards their duties and responsibilities in college campus.
- Teachers should follow all norms and standards set by the college for the faculty from time to time.
- Teaching staff should be present in the campus at least 10 minutes before the commencement of college timing.
- Teaching faculty should complete their syllabus in a stipulated time.
- Teaching staff should perform his academic assigned job by following UGC norms.
- Teachers should up-date themselves academically to facilitate students.
- Teachers should sanction their leaves in advance and need to do alternate arrangement of a class.
- Teaching staff should not involve in any unethical behavior and practices.
- Teachers should offer equal treatment to all the students.

- Teachers should strive for the personal development of students.
- Teachers should be available for students as facilitator and guide to assist them in shaping their personality.
- Teachers should have social relations with students and their parents.
- Teaching staff should have good coordination with his/her colleagues.
- Teachers should be consistent to maintain the interpersonal relationship in order to develop a team spirit.
- Teachers should take initiative and participate attentively in all college activities.

Code of Conduct for the Non-Teaching Staff

- Principal shall call CDC/IQAC meetings periodically to take review of a college progress.
- Principal shall write a confidential report of all staff of the institution.
